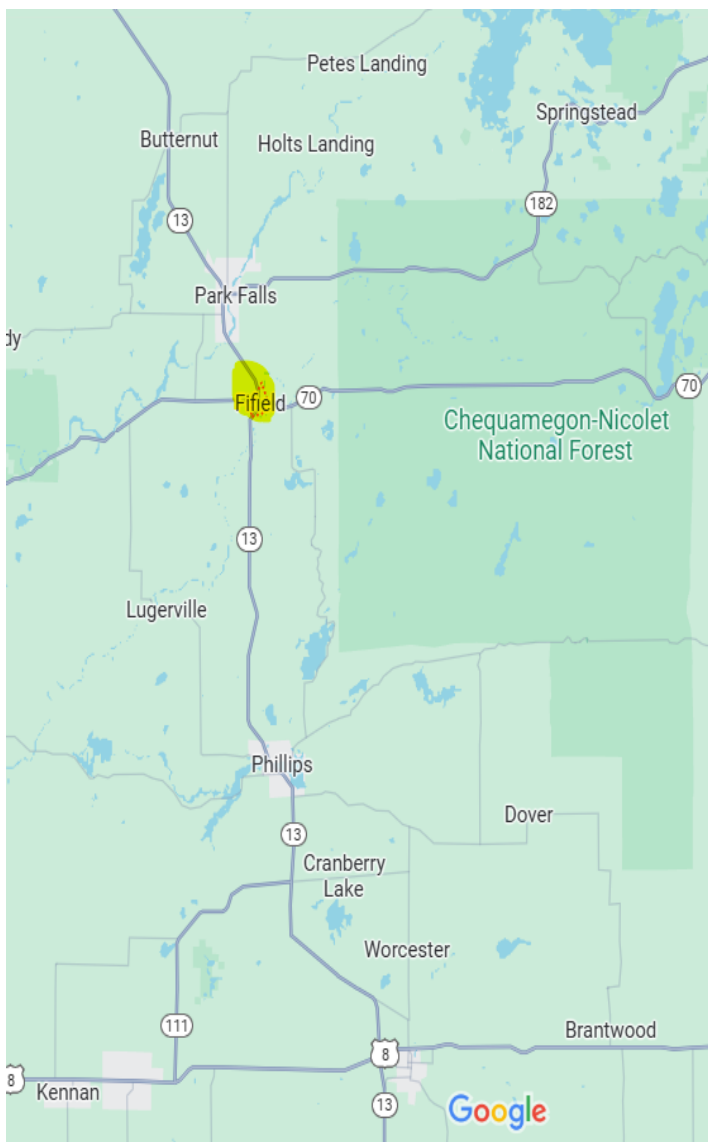

Some of the species that we expect to see during our field trips include Shadow, Lake, Mottled, Black-tipped, Fawn and Subarctic Darners. We also hope to encounter a variety of Somatochlora, including Williamsons, Skittipped and possibly Lake Emeralds, as well as Dragonhunters, Black-shouldered Spinylegs, and a variety of Bluets, Spreadwings, and Skimmers
